



S.T.A.Y.

The STAY project is a relatively new initiative which acts like a stepping stone for young people coming out of care or on the edge of care who are being moved into their own accommodation but don't quite have the skills to live independently.

We are looking to promote STAY and recruit people who are interested in giving these young people an opportunity and a bit of support so that they don't fail at this transitional point in their life.

In return, the Northern Trust offers support visits, training and a financial payment of £901.15 every 4 weeks for young persons placed. The young persons are deemed low risk and in some form of education or training and most importantly, willing to move into a STAY placement.

With the STAY project, the hosts are able to maintain their current job/roles/responsibilities alongside their new role as a support for our young people.
