Officially opened with great ceremony on 14 October 1866, St Peter's Cathedral, with its iconic twin spires, has stood at the heart of West Belfast ever since.

This special guided tour offers a unique opportunity to explore areas of the Cathedral that are rich in history and significance, including:

The Chapel of the Resurrection, where three Bishops of Down and Connor are laid to rest.

The Sanctuary, home to the Bishop's Cathedra (official seat).

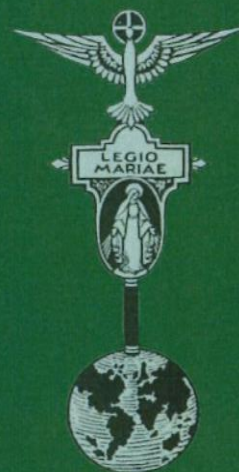
